The jury doubted the nun

The jury didn't believe the 71-year-old nun.

Sister Norma Milton, of Summer Street, had insisted that Kelvin Kimble, 31, of Wilton Street near Vince,, was the man who forced his way into her home and beat and robbed her on Dec. 16, 1991.

"There is no doubt in my mind," Milton testified. "He's the man that did it. He was in my house for 10 minutes"

"Even a nun can be mistaken or even lying for that matter" defense lawyer A. Charles Peruto Jr. argued before Kimble's acquittal yesterday.

Peruto said Milton claimed that she had identified Kimble at a police lineup, "but there was no lineup in this case. She was trying to make it worse for my client."
